It is also comes one day before the annual ISMA ("Modal Analysis, Theory and Practice") and ISAAC ("Advanced Techniques in Applied and Numerical Acoustics") courses that are held on September 22-23, 2016. If you want to present your work, please send the title and an abstract of approximately 200 words to <u>b-yan@abav.be</u> **before August 21**st. Notification of acceptance and further guidelines will be given by August 26th. Note that submissions are only open to students and young professionals (under age 40) who work on acoustics or related areas, and those based in Belgium and neighboring countries will have priority.

Authors will prepare and print a poster in A0 or A1 portrait format to present their work. Authors will have one minute in a plenary session to introduce the context of their poster while a projection of their poster is shown. To help the organizers coordinate all the posters, please send your final poster in pdf format to <u>b-yan@abav.be</u> before September 19th.
